Thinking within the Text

<i>Students</i>						
Notifies and discusses interesting vocabulary.						
Recalls important information from the text.						
Summarizes parts of a text or the entire text.						

Thinking beyond the Text

<i>Students</i>						
Makes predictions about what will happen.						
Connects the text to personal experiences.						
Brings background knowledge to the text.						
Connects the text to other texts.						
Infers cause and effect.						
Infers characters' motives and feelings; infers what the writer has implied.						
Identifies new information and incorporates it into present understandings.
